- If you cannot lead your walk as advertised in the programme, please contact the Committee.

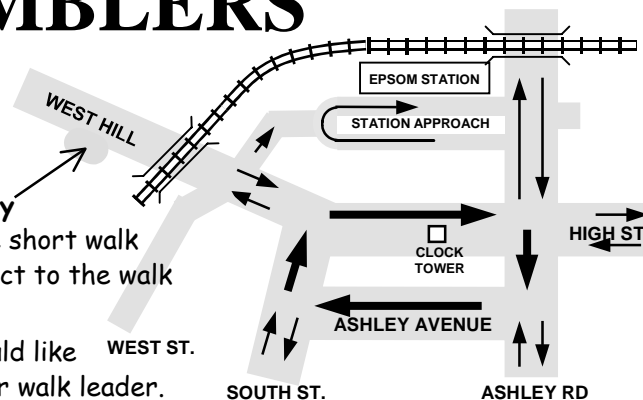
Additional notes
